



BEHAVIOUR **EVERY** LESSON

Queue sensibly outside classrooms

Remove Coats and bags before entering the classroom

Enter the classroom when instructed to, and stand behind your designated seat

Sit down in designated seat, when instructed to. Remain seated during the lesson

Do not talk when the teacher or other students are talking

Follow instructions immediately, without challenge or defiance

Respect the environment, other students and members of staff in the classroom

Do not eat or chew gum during lessons

Arrive with all the correct equipment required for a lesson

ATTITUDE **EVERY** LESSON

Attend school whenever possible, asking how to catch up if lessons are missed

Ensure you are on time to all lessons

Use time effectively, purposefully working to maximise your potential and complete tasks to the best of your ability

Take pride and ownership of work. Keep books organised, following the standards of presentation guidance

Be actively involved in lessons, asking and answering questions. Avoid being passive or coasting

Listen to others and engage in the work set. Avoid distractions

Be respectful to other students and staff, and follow instructions

Know your target grade and what you need to do to improve and achieve

BEHAVIOUR **EVERY** DAY

Students should use the seating provided and not sit on the floor anywhere within the school buildings.

Walk purposefully and sensibly within school buildings, keeping to the left.

Footballs and other balls are only used on the field and kept in bags at other times.

No mobile phones to be visible or used at any time.

Do not enter areas that are out of bounds at break/lunchtimes

Visiting lockers or collecting water should take place before school, at break or lunchtimes.

Language used anywhere on the school site, should be appropriate. Talking should be at an appropriate volume.

All litter should be placed in the bins. Respect the environment.

Wear the correct uniform at all times, with no nail varnish, inappropriate hair styles or colour, or trainers.

Respect the school environment.

Deliberate damage, graffiti or vandalism will be dealt with as a serious behaviour incident.

Exits or busy corridors should be kept clear to avoid congestion.

Behaviour and conduct should be calm and respectful at all times

Use the toilets at break and lunchtime, not within lessons, where possible.

At the end of the day, leave the school site using the front entrance/exit, not the field.

Behaviour to and from school in the local community, should also be appropriate

Mobile Phone Policy

Punctuality Expectations and Consequences

The school has a ban on mobile phones at all times during the day on the school site. This includes before and after form time and lessons, whilst students are on the school site. Phones should be turned off and in bags/coats, not visible at any time.

If phones are seen or heard, they will be automatically confiscated by staff. The phone will be taken to student reception and placed into a named envelope, to be collected by the student at the end of the day (first offence). For persistent offenders, parents will be informed and will have to collect phones themselves from the student reception. If students refuse to hand over a confiscated phone, then this is seen as defiance and will result in being sent to the BASE for the day, a behaviour point recorded and a CLD issued.

Students are expected to be punctual to all form times (8.55am) and lessons throughout the day. Bells will indicate when students are expected to be either lined up or in the classroom for these points during the school day.

Should students fail to be on time, a 'L' will be added to SIMS with a record of the minutes late. Three L's within a week (SIMS report to be run Thursday break time) will result in a Behaviour point and a CLD on a Friday at 3.25-4.15pm. Failure to attend a Punctuality CLD will result in another Behaviour point added to SIMS and a SCFTE within the LINK.
